Hello Samantha Smith Families,

Today, we welcomed all of our newest little Samantha Smith Kindergarteners. Welcome little Dolphins! Our systems are in place and we are up and running. We need your help with before and after school safety.

Safety Tips:

- Please do not enter our building when dropping off or picking up your student. We are working to limit traffic within the building.
- If you are dropping your student across the street from the school, they need to cross at our crosswalk. Running across the street (especially at the end of the bus chute (closest to the big toy) is NOT SAFE!
- We ask that you use actual crosswalks to walk your child onto campus (the bus chute is for our buses only).
- If you are walking your student to school, you can drop them at the front of the school. Students can access their classrooms by walking through the school to their lineup. **Even our students in the portables.
- At no time are we allowing cars to pass through the side gate and enter the back of our school.
- If you can access pick up through our drive thru, we ask that you take advantage of this instead of parking and walking to get your student. Traffic in the parking lot slows the process for all.
- This year, students are not allowed to ride any bus other than the one they were assigned. Gone are the times of riding home with a friend. At least for now.
- At pick up, please remember we need three feet spacing. We are working to teach students this in all areas of the day, we need your help.

Change to Kinder Morning Line Up:

We need to make a change to where three of our kindergarten classes line up each morning. See school map below. Your student's teacher will be communicating this directly to you as well.

nclement Weather:

Being that we live in the Pacific Northwest, it is very important you prepare your student with a raincoat (with hood if possible) and appropriate shoes. Being a partially outdoor campus, there are many times throughout the day that students will find themselves outside.

Curriculum Night:

If you were unable to attend Curriculum Night, contact your student's teacher to get missed information.

Too Sick for School:

We appreciate each of you taking the health and safety of all here at school very seriously. I have attached the "Too Sick for School" district guidance in case you have questions around COVID-19 symptoms. We are all thankful to be back in person.
